1. NATURE AND NAME OF EVENT: A restricted event known as The 2020 Swartland Rally
2. DATE OF EVENT: 18/4/2020
3. DESCRIPTION OF EVENT: A Reliability and Regularity Trial over a total distance of approximately 190 kilometres starting at 09h00 hours on 18/4/20 from Cape Town and finishing about 15h30 hours on 18/4/20 at Shelley Point.
4. PROMOTERS: The Crankhandle Club of SA
5. JURISDICTION: Held under the international Sporting Codes of the Federation Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) and/or the Federation Internationale Motocycliste (FIM), the General Competition Rules (GCRs) of Motorsport South Africa (MSA), the Standing Supplementary Regulations (VSRs) of the Southern African Veteran and Vintage Association, (SAVVA), amended January 2009, and these Supplementary Regulations (SRs).

8. ELIGIBILITY: [See VSRs 8, 10 (b) and (c) and 14.] Open to members of any club affiliated to SAVVA driving motor vehicles/motorcycles manufactured before 31 December 1985.
9. ENTRIES: [SEE VSRs 10 AND 11.] The official ENTRY FORM is attached. Entries open immediately and all entries must be sent to: woodward@icon.co.za

Fully completed Entry Forms must reach the organisers by not later than 28 March 2020 together with the entry fee of R415 **if booked and paid by 12 March**, and R515 **if after 12 March 2020**. The minimum number of entries is 20 and the maximum is 27..
10. METHOD OF SETTING SPEEDS: [See VSR 24] Speeds will be set in accordance with Method 1 as defined in VSR 24 (a). A choice of the following speed groups is offered on the Entry Form.

A - 100km/h B - 80 km/h C - 60 km/h D - Touring Group

11. COMPETITION NUMBERS AND STARTING TIMES: [See VSR 16.] Competition numbers will be supplied by the organisers and must be returned at the finish of the event, if required [VSR 16(b)].

12. Competition numbers and starting times will be advised in the Final Instructions [See VSR 6 (c)]. Competition numbers will be displayed in accordance with VSR 16 (f) and s

17. TIME KEEPING AND CONTROLS: [See VSRs 26, 27 and 28.] Sealed watches will not be required. Open, secret, hidden, and self-timed controls may be used. Secret controls will be operated in terms of Method 1 (delete as applicable) as defined in VSR 26 (a)(ii).

COMPETITION LICENCE: A member in possession of a current valid membership card of any MSA affiliated or any SAVVA affiliated club is deemed to be in possession of a Restricted Competition Licence which mentions affiliation to SAVVA and has the inclusion of a Restricted Competition Licence. The Restricted Competition Licence is valid for SAVVA authorized events as well as for events hosted by MSA associated clubs requiring a Restricted Competition Licence.

For this event it is required that the vehicle entered be dated by SAVVA and a Dating Certificate issued. Alternatively, the entrant should submit adequate proof that the vehicle complies with the eligibility conditions of entry.

24. CLASSES, PRIZES AND AWARDS: These will be awarded as per the CHC trophy register (at discretion of organisers).
